## How to Place an Order

Order by phone at **1-800-4PD-INFO**. The Helpline is open Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. ET.

Order by email at <u>Helpline@Parkinson.org</u> with subject line "VA Resources Request" and <u>include</u>:

- Name of PADRECC or Consortium Center
- Point of contact
- Address where materials should be sent
- Desired resources (quantities are listed next to each resource category)
